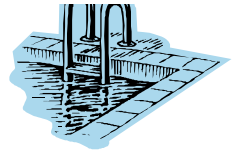


Swimming Pool Rules



1. No person may use the pool unless it is officially open and the lifeguards are on duty.
2. All instructions given by the lifeguards are to be followed.
3. Admission to the pool may be denied for any of the following reasons:
 - ◆ Intoxication.
 - ◆ Open sores, wounds, skin infections, and nasal or ear discharges.
 - ◆ Any condition or evidence, which in the opinion of the manager will jeopardize the health and safety of the membership.
4. 3 whistles = everyone must clear the pool.
5. No running allowed. Patrons must **walk** in pool and restroom areas.
6. Diving is permitted only in the deep end and diving well. Please note signs around pool edges.
7. Running, pushing, causing undue disturbance, or any conduct that may endanger the welfare of self or other patrons is prohibited.
8. Children under 5 years of age or non- swimmers must be supervised by a responsible person, who is in the water and remains within arms reach of the child. Persons unable to pass a swim test must stay in water that is not over their shoulders.
9. Flotation devices will be permitted in shallow water at the manager's discretion. An adult must be within arms reach of the child. Flotation devices such as inner-tubes and arm floats are not permitted.
10. Proper swimming attire must be worn. T-Shirts are discouraged and will be allowed only at the manager's discretion.
11. Infants/children not toilet trained must wear **swim** diapers under swim suits. No diapers please.
12. Spitting, blowing of nose into the pool or onto deck, improper public displays of affection and profanity is prohibited.

13. Inflatable beach balls or sponge balls are allowed in the pool during non-crowded conditions and at the manager's discretion.
14. Food and drinks are permitted on the food deck.
15. Glass containers or breakable objects of any kind are not permitted in the pool area, restrooms, or outside deck.
16. All injuries occurring within the pool area or restrooms must be reported to the manager on duty immediately.
17. Children's strollers **must** remain at least 4 feet from the side of the pool next to shallow water.
18. Smoking is not permitted inside the pool gates.
19. No animals inside the pool area.
20. The Fairfield – Fairfield Crest Swim Pool assumes no liability for the loss or theft of member's personal belongings. Items left in pool area at the end of the day will be placed in the pool's lost and found.
21. The pool manager or lifeguard may close the entire pool complex, or any portions of the pool complex for any safety or maintenance reason.
22. The pool manager or lifeguard on duty has the authority to enforce these rules and may remove any patron who violates these rules from the Fairfield - Fairfield Crest Swim Pool.
